Chamber and Laughlin Tourism Committee launch new program – Volunteers in Partnership

LAUGHLIN, NV – Several times a year, volunteers are needed to work on community wide events sponsored by the Laughlin Tourism Committee such as SCORE, Laughlin River Stampede, Laughlin Xtreme Bulls, and the Laughlin River Run. Without the tireless commitment of volunteers working at these events, we would be challenged to provide a quality experience for our visitors. Until now, the Chamber has not had a formalized program to recognize or show our appreciation for these hardworking and dedicated folks. We are launching a new committee called “Volunteers in Partnership” beginning February 1st.

“We have had great support from all of our volunteers over the years and really wanted to come up with a way to recognize them for their efforts. We think this program is a good start and can’t wait to begin giving the kind of credit and recognition that our volunteers deserve in a very public way,” says Laughlin Tourism Committee Director Jena Morga.

Under the leadership of Judy Royer – committee chair – and Kathryn Cornelison – Chamber Member Services - we will be recruiting 75 volunteers to work gates, VIP tents, and beer and water booths at town-wide events. In return for hours worked, volunteers will receive a logo shirt to wear at events, an ID badge, a Tam card, one meal per shift, complimentary incentives, a ticket to the annual thank you luncheon to be held in late March or early April and a “Laughlin” gift at the luncheon. Complimentary incentives will include items such as buffet lunch coupons, show tickets, hotel rooms, and dining certificates.
